Always the green thumb, she surrounded herself with the beauty of flowers and plants. This often included using them for homemaking purposes such as meals, jams, and canned goods. One of her favorite farm pastimes was sitting together shelling purple hull peas with friends and family. A few of her favorite memories include fishing, cross country motorcycles trips, camping, all things travel, 42 games and reading. In all her travels, she enjoyed collecting unique pieces of jewelry.

Alice had a deep connection with animals, her favorites being eagles, hummingbirds, and cats. She was a dedicated animal rights philanthropist,

and her beloved cats will live on as a reminder for us all to care for God's creatures.

Alice enjoyed using her creative skills to make beautiful paintings and other handicrafts. She was also quite the seamstress and would make many of her children and grandchildren's clothing. However, she also greatly enjoyed shopping trips with her granddaughters. The family will cherish the many quilts that she has gifted them throughout the years. Alice loved many things, but her greatest love was that of her Savior, Jesus.

Those left to cherish Alice's memories are her daughter, Rhonda Joiner; son, Kevin Kent; stepchildren, Kimberly Schlener and husband Dave, Scott Hunnicutt and wife Carrie, and Kelly Hunnicutt and wife Stacey. 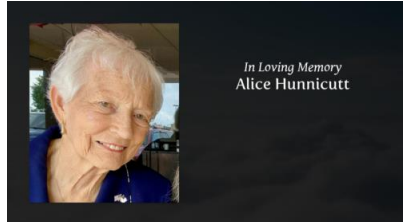
