Bette Sue Farmer, formerly of Scurry and recently of Terrell, passed away peacefully on the morning of Jan. 28, 2025. Bette was born September 14, 1940 in Weslaco, TX to Robert and Millie Emerson, both of whom preceded her in death along with her husband, Bobby Farmer, in 2021 and her son, Kelly Farmer, in 2023 and her younger sister, Grace Ann Emerson.

Bette worked as an accountant in bookkeeping with several firms in the Dallas metro area including Mercantile Bank and Chase Bank for over 38 years. She and Bobby were married in 1962, and they lived in Dallas until moving to Scurry in the 1990s. In 2011, they moved to Terrell where retirement suited them and they enjoyed getting to know their new neighbors. She and Bobby were longtime members of Landmark Church of Christ in Kaufman and Bette loved traveling with Bobby in their RV to go camping and visit historic western and cowboy locations that were rich in historical details and stories. Bette was a devoted wife and dedicated mother as well and her proudest accomplishments included the birth of Kelly and her almost four decades long career in the accounting divisions of each company she worked with.

Bette is survived by her grandson, Jake Farmer and his wife, Emerald Scott-Farmer; brother, Robert Emerson, daughter-in-law, Sharon Farmer; brother-in-law, Donald Farmer and neighbors, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Cox as well as other extended family and church family.
