Bobby "Bob" Dwayne Gheen, age 78, passed away peacefully with loved ones by his side on November 5, 2023. Bob was born in Gun Barrel City, Texas on August 6, 1945, to Jack W. and Lillie B. Gheen, both of whom have preceded him in death along with his beloved wife, Carol Kerr Gheen.

way to resolve matters in a fair and respectful way. The distributors liked Bob for many reasons but the two most important ones were that the distributors trusted Bob and knew that he was always fair to them.
