Bobby Kent Moore was born in Kaufman County, Texas on October 4, 1929 to the late Jessie and Ethel McMahan Moore. He passed away peacefully on Easter Sunday, March 27, 2016 and entered into the presence of his Lord. 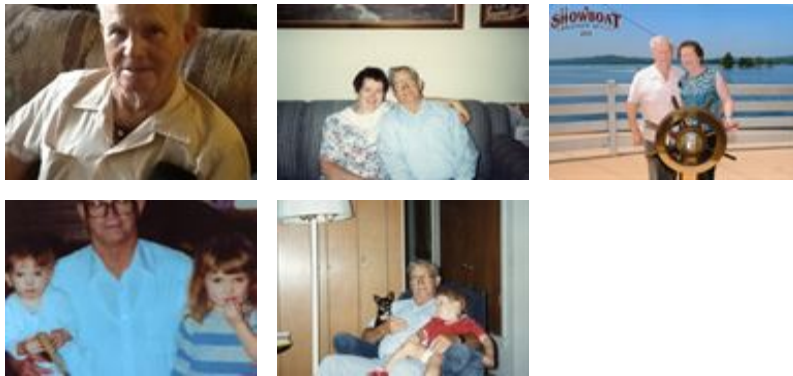
