Cecil Gail Felts was born in Kilmichael, Mississippi on March 11, 1937 to Louie and Cecil Gail Felts. She registered for Heaven at 10 when she first heard the message of salvation in Christ, and her life was changed! She attended Mississippi Baptist College where God provided for her every need. With a teaching degree, Gail's first job was fourth grade in Biloxi, Mississippi. One year later, she met and married J.N. Williams and they had 3 children. Devoting herself to the Lord Jesus Christ home and family became the focus of her life.

Gail is preceded in death by brothers Paul, Ralph and Jimmy, and beloved granddaughter Lauren Williams. She is survived by her devoted husband J.N. Williams; her children: Jeffrey (Jan), Steve (Karen), and Melissa Helm (Rodney); and her grandchildren: Erin, Anna, Joshua, Joah, Nathan, Jess, Sara, Audrey, Judson, Gracen, and Caroline. She is also survived by six great-grandchildren - Elijah, Ezra, Josiah, Ford, Levi and another baby boy soon to arrive - as well as her brother Leon Felts and sister Lorita Gay.

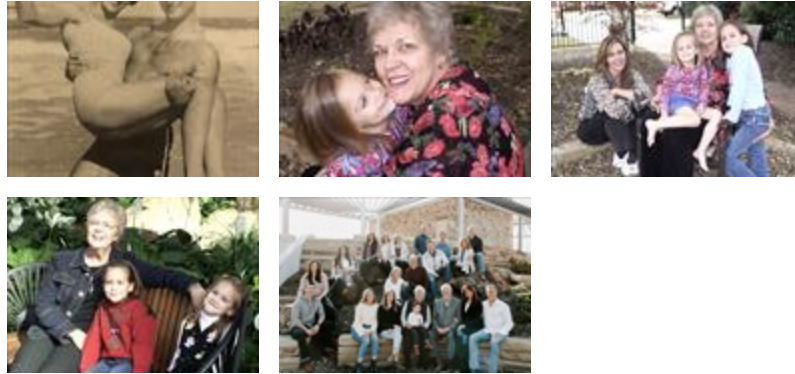
