Rev. Dr. Charles (Chuck) Aaron passed away unexpectedly on November 29, 2023. Chuck was born in 1956, in Memphis, Tennessee, to Charles Lynn Aaron, Sr. and Kathryn Brewer Aaron. Chuck grew up in Memphis, graduated from Christian Brothers High School in 1974, and from Lambuth College in Jackson, Tennessee in 1978. He had a masters degree in Counseling from Memphis State University, a Masters of Divinity from Perkins School of Theology at SMU, and a Ph. D. in Old Testament from Union Theological Seminary in Richmond, Virginia.

Chuck is survived by his wife of 38 years, Sandra Miller Aaron, sister Terry Clarke and her husband Roy, sister Jan Gould and her husband David, nephews Devin Clarke, Sean Clarke, and Alex Gould, and niece Kaylee Gould.

Chuck was an ordained elder in The United Methodist Church, and served as pastor of many churches over the years. He was a beloved pastor, who was known for his thought-provoking sermons and Bible studies. For the last several years, he served as Director of the Intern Program at Perkins School of Theology, where he helped to mold seminary students into pastors. He was also a published author, having written/edited books, and contributed to many other publications. He will be remembered as a loving husband, brother, uncle, friend, mentor, encourager, theologian, professor, and for his deep faith. He exemplified all that a pastor and a Christian should be, and was a positive influence in countless lives.
