Charles Edward Morgan, of Terrell, passed away into the presence of his Lord and Savior on March 10, 2021 at his home with family at his side. A loving husband, father, grandfather, great grandfather and friend, Charles will be greatly missed by all who knew him.

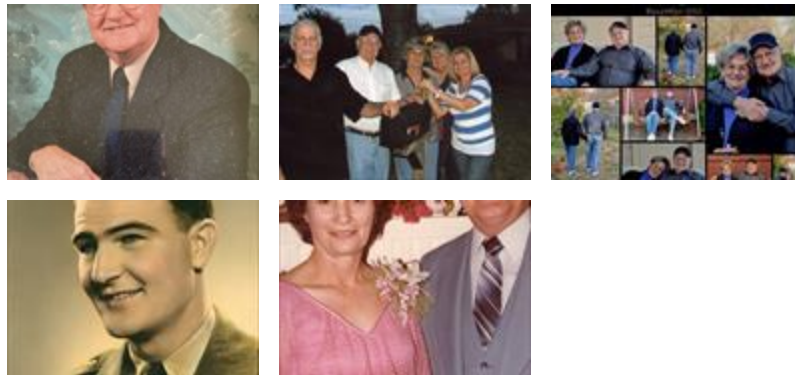

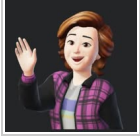
