Charlotte Mae Fowler was born in Arkansas City, Arkansas, on November 18, 1949, Charlotte Mae Rasbury died in Terrell, Texas, on November 24, 2023. She was Stout and Eunice Fowler's seventeenth child. Charlotte and her siblings used to go hunting, fishing, swimming, and playing in the woods in their small town on the Mississippi River. She went to live with her mother in Dallas, Texas, after graduating from high school. Paul Rasbury and Charlotte were wed on April 5, 1968. Michael and Christopher Rasbury are the two sons of Charlotte and Paul's marriage. Charlotte spent forty-three years as a Blue Cross and Blue Shield employee before retiring. In Corsicana, on Richland Chambers Lake, Charlotte and Paul constructed their retirement residence.

Since Charlotte was a huge kid herself, she loved all children. When her son Chris was an active Boy Scout, she served as a leader for the organization. Charlotte participated in Kung-Fu and earned her green belt in the sport. Charlotte was a collector and adored all things Barbie. She has happy recollections of playing on the stairs and popping an air mattress with her nieces and nephews. Paul then grounded them all to the couch for ten minutes before buying another one at the store. Charlotte adores Christmas, and she used to look forward to the "Right Family" game each year.

In September 2020, Charlotte relocated to Terrell to live with her nieces Amber and Catelynn Meador. Charlotte received an Alzheimer's diagnosis in

November 2020. Charlotte told her Hospice care team that Amber was the daughter she never had, and that Amber took excellent care of her. She spent her last years living the life of a princess.

Charlotte is preceded in death by her husband Paul, her son Michael, her parents, 15 brothers and sisters, and her grandparents.

Charlotte is survived by her son Chris Rasbury and wife Tamara, her niece/daughter Amber and Tony Meador and grandkids Coty (wife Mary), Zachary, Olivia, and Isabella Rasbury, Zackery, Catelynn (Fiancé Dylan), and Heyleigh Meador. Great-Grandson William Rasbury and baby on the way. Sister-in-law Marcia and Donald Jones. Brother Orville Fowler and Anita. And a host of nieces, nephews, and friends.
