Christine Crow, beloved wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother, passed away peacefully on Dec. 20, 2022 at her home. She was born April 10, 1948 in Terrell to WA and Hazel Gheen, both of whom preceded her in death along with her brother, Randolph Gheen.
