



## Clyde Scott

July 2, 1945 - January 12, 2021

Clyde Scott, of Terrell, passed away on Jan. 12, 2021. Clyde was born July 2, 1945 in Wills Point, TX to Forest Gilford and Catherine (Johnson) Scott, both of whom preceded him in passing along with his sisters: Joyce Cornwell, Fern Carter and Patricia Scott.

Clyde graduated from Wills Point High School in 1963, and enlisted in the US Navy where he served with honor and distinction. 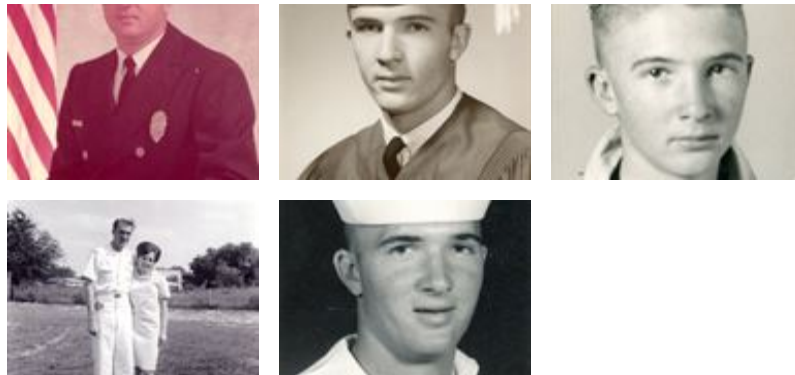
