MSGT Dicky Pirtle, US Army (Ret.), beloved father and grandfather, passed away with family at his side on March 9, 2018. Dicky was born October 18, 1940 in Terrell, Texas to Bea F. (Dick) and Jessie Pirtle. Both his parents preceded him in death along with his granddaughter, Heather Miers and his brother, Buddy Pirtle. Dicky retired from the US Army having served honorably and with distinction including in Vietnam for three tours. He was one of the original Green Berets in the Special Forces Unit and for his bravery and heroism, he was awarded the Bronze Medal. Later in life, he worked for, and also retired from, the Mesquite ISD in the maintenance department. He loved to ride motorcycles and was an active member of ABATE and J.A.B. motorcycle clubs. Dicky was an avid outdoorsman and was a member of the NRA and his plainspoken personality was like a breath of fresh air to all who met him. He was a loyal friend who could be counted on to help in any way he could and his memory will be cherished forever. 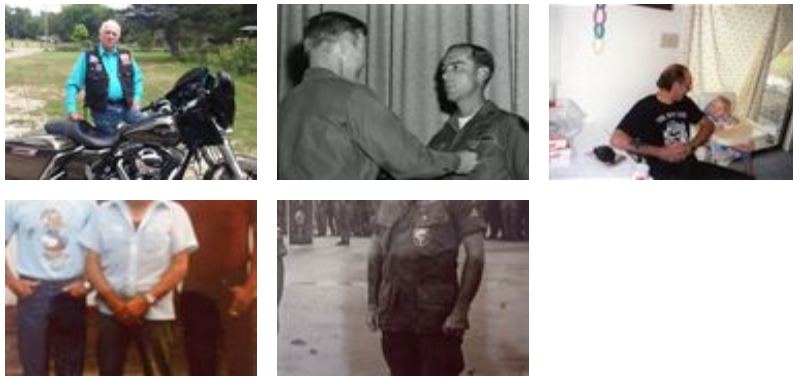
