Mr. Don Grabbs, of Terrell, passed away on Jan. 28, 2025 in Dallas, Texas. Don was born on June 18, 1946, in Terrell to Willie (Bill) and Windell Grabbs, both of whom preceded him in death along with his brother, Perry Grabbs and sister-in-law, June Grabbs.

Although born in Terrell, Don later made his home in the nearby community of Elmo, where he was well known and beloved. A graduate of Terrell High School, he furthered his education at East Texas State University. Don served with honor and distinction in the US Navy for 6 years, including service aboard Annapolis III (AGMR-1) during the Vietnam era. After his military service, he returned home and embarked on a successful career in overland transport as the owner and operator of Don Grabbs Trucking. He truly enjoyed driving, traveling, and experiencing the many parts of America. When he wasn't on the road, Don was passionate about repairing and restoring cars and was a loyal supporter and fan of the Dallas Cowboys.

Don is survived by his brother, Larry Grabbs; his sons Nick Grabbs and wife, Christine; Patrick Grabbs and Andrew Grabbs and partner, Amanda Darr; and his grandchildren Savannah Grabbs, James Grabbs, and Clementine Grabbs, as well as other extended family.
