



Doris Etheridge

November 1, 1935 - March 1, 2025

Doris Ann Sy Etheridge died on March 1, 2025, at her home in Terrell, Texas. She was born on November 1, 1935, in Dallas to Paul Emil Adolph Sy and his wife Katherine Anna Dooley, whose passings preceded hers, as did those of sisters Shirley, Carolyn, and Nancy, and former husband Jackie Kenneth Etheridge.

Ms. Etheridge grew up in Dallas and graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School. A year later, she married Mr. Etheridge, a native of Parvin who worked at Grand Avenue Bank, where she also was employed. Ms. Etheridge worked in banking for the entirety of her career. The couple had two children: Mark, born in 1959, and Lori, born in 1961. They divorced in 1972.

After Ms. Etheridge's retirement, she devoted herself to her family, including grandchildren Jeremy Wilson, Natalie Fontenot, Gregory Fontenot, Nicholas Etheridge, and Emily Etheridge. She also was blessed with six great-grandchildren.

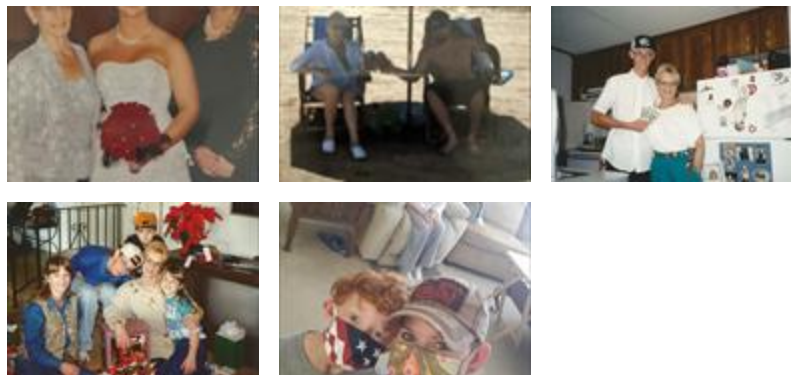
