Lilah Elizabeth Mirick (Lib), daughter of T.D. (Dock) and Mattie (Wright) Mirick was born September 28, 1924, in Lawrence, Texas. Lib attended school in Lawrence and graduated from Terrell High School. She studied accounting at North Texas State Teachers College, now North Texas University. She was employed by the McCord Co., Swift & Co. and Kelpen Ice Cream Co. before being associated with John F. Hinton, CPA for twelve years. She operated her own bookkeeping and tax service for several years before being employed by the American National Bank in the trust department. She retired from the American National Bank Dec. 28, 1989 as vice-president and trust officer. Lib often remarked that her mentor, John Hinton, was a fine Christian gentleman and that any success she had in her career was due to his kindness. She was active in several civic and social associations. Including the Business and Professional Women's Club, The Pilot Club of Terrell, Beta Sigma Phi (Omega Chapter), Kaufman County Senior Citizen Assoc., and the Women's Fellowship of Poetry UMC. She was a longtime member of the Methodist Church before joining First Christian Church in 1980. She always enjoyed her many friends, most of whom, are now deceased. She loved her family very much and was grateful for their love for her.

Lib is survived by her nephew Stan Ballard, Jr. and niece Bettye Ballard; great nephews: West Ballard and wife, Amanda; Dock Ballard and wife, Veronica; great-great nieces and nephews: Aidan and Adison Ballard, Alexandria Wilkerson and Grant Ballard. Visitation will be Thursday, June 7, 2018 at

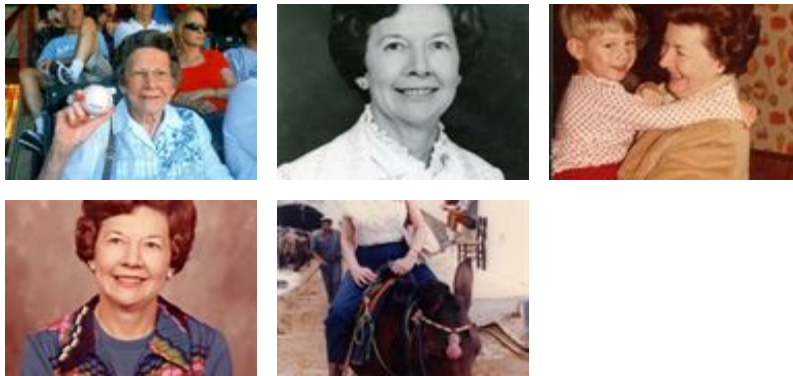
