Freida Kay Baugh, aged 69, passed away peacefully on Thursday, September 19, 2024 in Terrell, Texas. She was born in Dallas, TX on November 28, 1954 to Alta Wilson Baugh and James Edmond Baugh. She was preceded in death by her parents, and her brother, James Weston Baugh. She is survived by her daughter, Amber Shay Clowers, her fiance, Harold Kines, Jr., two grandchildren, Austin Trey Clowers and Zoe Adora Clowers, one sister, Linda Baugh Riedel, nieces, nephews, extended family and friends.

She tailored a gorgeous wedding gown and veil for her daughter, as well as numerous items for her grandchildren.

Her faith in Unelanvhi (The Great Spirit) drove her strength and compassion as she nursed loved ones. She nurtured her child, grandchildren, nieces, nephews, and many young souls along her journey through life. Her calm

nature made her easy to talk to, and her devotion gave her family and friends warm feelings of love and security. Freida used her healing touch to comfort those in pain with kindness and massage. She dedicated her attention to caring for her parents and brother during their final seasons of life. Her heart was pure; she will be greatly missed.
