Gary Harwell, beloved husband, father, brother and friend, passed away from long term illnesses and Covid19. Gary Stephen Harwell, Sr. was born in Terrell, Texas to Jim William Harwell and Lola Bessie (Stephens) Harwell, both of whom preceded him in death with Jim passing in 1994 and Bessie in 1984. Gary was also met in Heaven by his brothers, Dennis Ray Harwell who passed in 2006 and Rayford Lewis Harwell in 2015.

Gary married Linda Kay Feagin May 8, 1964 in Terrell and to this union two sons were born. He also worked for the Garland Fire Dept. and retired in 2003 after 31 years of dedicated and loyal service. In 2003, he was diagnosed with Multi Myeloma and, in 2019, with CIDP (Chronic Inflammatory Demyelinating Polyneuropathy).
