



## Glenn E. Pulley

January 11, 1934 - January 15, 2018

Glenn Ellen Pulley, born Jan. 11, 1934, went to be with the Lord on Jan. 15, 2018 at 84 years of age. She was the youngest child of Jesse and Josie Cude of Malakoff, TX and her parents , 12 brothers and 1 sister all preceded her in death.

She married David R. "Pete" Pulley in 1951 and had three children. She and her husband were ministers and pastored Terrell First Assembly of God Church, Terrell, Tx for 42 years. She was ordained through Victory Fellowship International and retained her ordination at her death. Her son, David M. Pulley, and her husband, Rev. D. R. "Pete" Pulley preceded her in death. She is survived by two daughters, Kay Pulley and Carmen Pulley, both of Mesquite, TX. She also leaves behind many close family members including one brother-in-law, Dean Pulley of Athens, one sister-in-law, Joann Cude of Houston, and two cousins, Bud and Paul Cude. She was known to be very effective at “giving orders” (which her daughters can attest to) and would leave everyone with a final order to keep singing and be ready to meet the Lord.

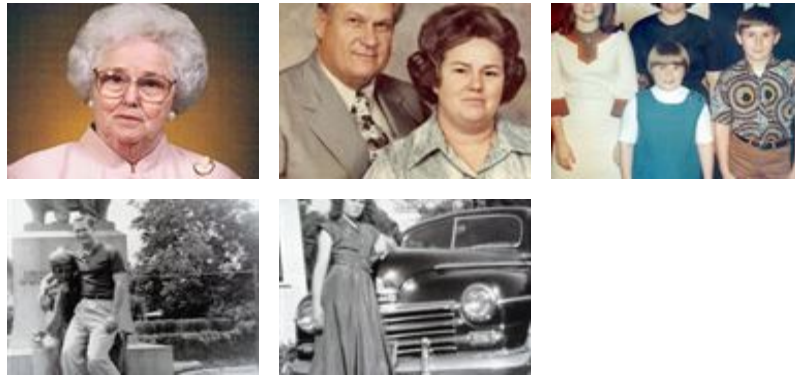

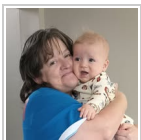
