He had a connection with horses and skills at riding and training cutting horses that were widely known. His love for roping and cowboying gave him the opportunity to become closer to the Lord and share that with others.

Of all the things that made H.B. proud, he was the proudest to have raised three beautiful daughters who lived their lives with a firm foundation in the Lord. 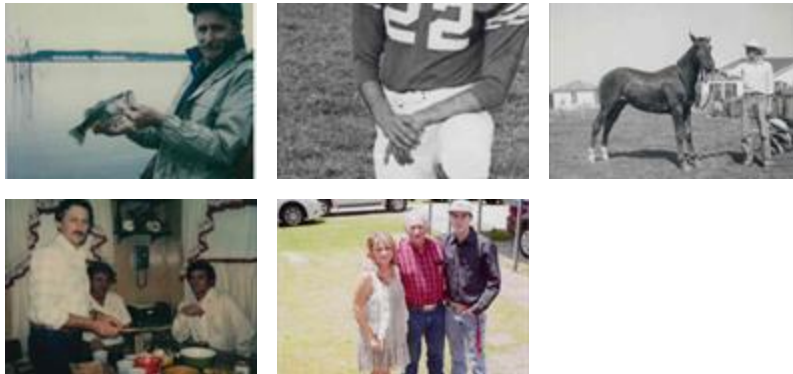
