James Thomas Cato, beloved son, brother, grandson, nephew and friend, passed away on September 24, 2018. James was born March 10, 2002 in Dallas to parents, Todd and Julie Cato, and making a big brother of Daniel. He was welcomed into Heaven by his Savior as well as his grandfathers, Thomas O. James was a junior at Poetry Community Christian School where his personality made instant friends of all who met him.
