Jerry was an amazing man, as he served God, family and country. He served in the Air Force during the Korean War and graduated with honors from the University of Houston with his Doctorate of Optometry. He was a member and president of the Rotary Club in La Marque, Texas, and he was chairman of the board at the College of the Mainland. Later in life, Jerry was ordained as a Deacon in the Catholic Church and served for over 25 years.

Everywhere they went, they would pick up a nativity set and at Christmas, those nativities brought joy to everyone. 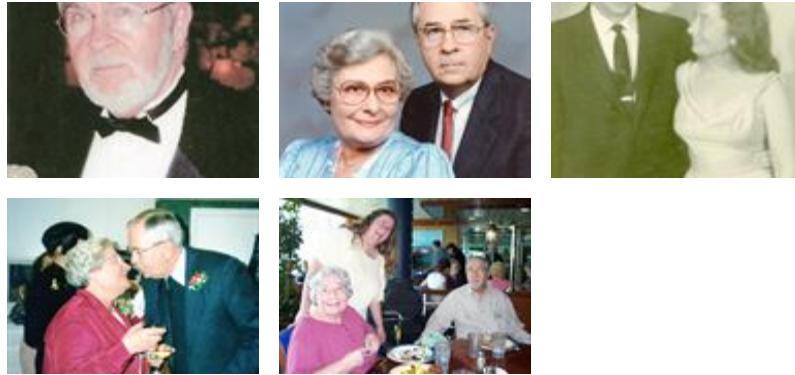
