Jerry Michael Burks, of Royse City, passed away peacefully on June 29, 2024 to be reunited with his loving wife, Linda, who preceded him in November of 2022. Jerry was also met in Heaven by his parents, Ray "Boogar" and Flo Burks, his son, Mike Burks and his brother, Ricky Burks, each of whom gladly rejoiced as he entered the Gates.

Jerry was born in Royse City on March 15, 1942 and was a 1960 graduate of Royse City High School. The oldest of five children, Jerry was a rock for his family after the passing of their father at a very young age. He was a blessing to his mother, Flo, and was a great help to her as their family navigated the loss of Mr. Burks. After graduation, he started working with Birdsong as a butcher in Terrell after which he began working with Patton's Economy Meat Market. While in Terrell, he volunteered with the local Scout Troop 390 and became the Scout Leader. His was an example of the type of man that put God first, then his family and all else after all the while putting "service above self". Jerry began working with Texas Power & Light where he worked his way to becoming a linemman and then, ultimately, a Foreman and he retired from TP&L (now Oncor) after over 30 years of dedicated service. Never one to stay at home, Jerry was offered a courier position with American National Bank which was a perfect fit for him. He retired 'for real' after ANB, staying home to do the thing he loved best-spend time with Linda and the family that God blessed them with. 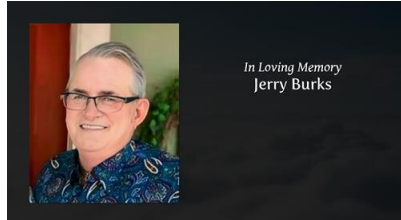

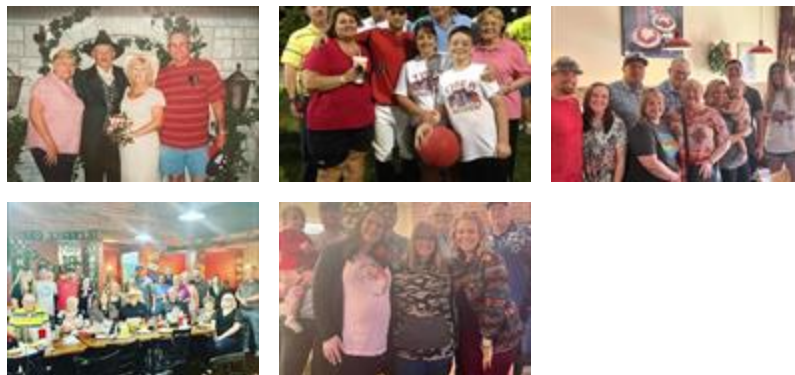
