Jerry Michael Morgan, of Garland, passed away peacefully on April 2, 2019 with his loving family at his side. Jerry began life as he lived it-serving in any way that he could for anyone that he could. He had his first job working at 16 with Safeway until they closed their stores in Texas. Having not only the knowledge for the grocery retail business but also the personality that made every customer feel like he was their best friend enabled Jerry to embark on a long and loyal career with Brookshires Grocery. He gained even more knowledge the old-fashioned way by working in every position including stocker, carry out, cashier, and then, management. Jerry worked at several Brookshires locations in Forney, Terrell and Quinlan until his retirement in 2017. His work ethic inspired so many coworkers because Jerry led by example in his commitment to exceptional customer service. His example of friendliness, helpful attitude to associates as well as shoppers, and his willingness to go the extra mile to place satisfaction in both shopping and working experience helped Jerry set the bar high in

achieving the best “neighborhood grocery store”. Many young men and women having their own first jobs considered Jerry to be the “Best Boss” and a true inspiration to set their goals high and never settle for less than exceptional. He was a familiar face in any community he worked in and could always be counted on to help on any occasion. Jerry was a man who loved the Lord with all his heart and loved his family with all his being. His legacy of caring, kindness and loyalty will be cherished by all who knew and loved him. 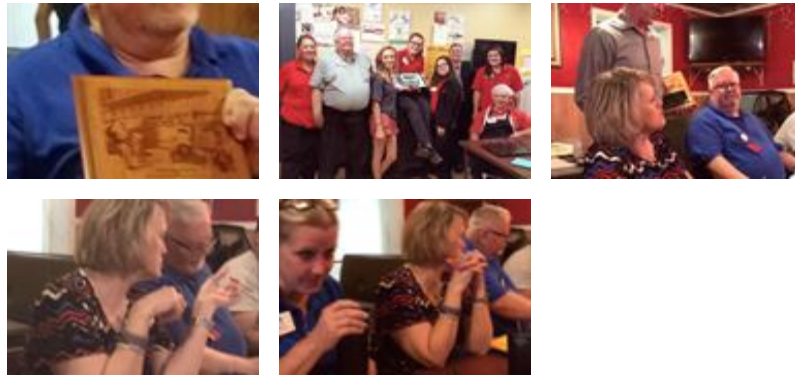

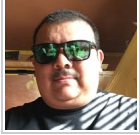
