December 16, 1916 - August 19, 2017

Jewel Lee Arington Dansby passed away on Saturday, August 19, 2017 at the age of 100. She was born December 16, 1916 in Tahlequah, Oklahoma to James Henry Arington and Dixie Ann Davidson Arington, and grew up in Arapaho, Oklahoma. She graduated from Arapaho High School in 1934, and married Hiram Elmo Dansby on October 31, 1936 in Quartzite, Arizona. The Dansbys moved to Terrell, Texas after WWII and operated a successful dairy north of Terrell until he passed away in 1957. They were members of the First Christian Church of Terrell, where she continued to worship throughout the rest of her life. Jewel was an active member of the Crusaders Adult Sunday School class for many years.

She worked as a dental hygienist at Terrell State Hospital for a number of years after her husband's death, then for East Texas Motor Freight, where she retired after years of service.

Jewel is preceded in death by her husband and parents, her son Phillip Glenn Davenport and great-granddaughter Victoria Sanders, as well as her brothers Zether, James Jr., Paul, and Billy Arington, and sister Opal. She was especially close to her brother Paul Arington and his wife Frances, of Arapaho, OK, sister Opal Woody of Oregon, and sister-in-law Tommie Squier. She is survived by her son Michael Edward Dansby, Sr., and wife Nancy of Terrell, three grandchildren, Michelle Lee Wright and husband Ed, of Blue Ridge, Texas and their children, Brad Duke and Elizabeth Wright; Michael Dansby Jr., of Ft. Worth, Texas, and daughters Marguerite, Mylie, Sasha, and

Aden; and James Dansby of Van, Texas, and children Zachary, Sierra, and Savannah.

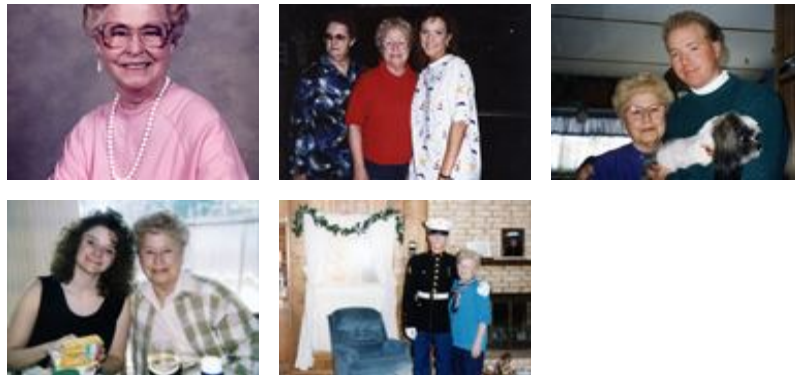
