Jim Bob Wynne was born on December 08, 1936, in Terrell, Texas to Lela Jane Farmer Wynne and James Harrison Wynne. He spent the early years of his life in the close-knit Poetry community, attending school and serving as a faithful and devoted member of Poetry United Methodist Church. Jim Bob attended Terrell High School and was an engaged member of FFA. During this time, he grew his lifelong love for cattle. After graduating from Terrell High School in 1955, Jim Bob attended Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas, where in 1959, he received a bachelor's degree in business with a focus in insurance. Post graduation, Jim Bob quickly went to work where he spent many years employed with Gerard Life Insurance. It was here that Jim Bob met and married his first wife, Sue Epperson. In 1968, the two would welcome their son, James Robert Wynne. In 1983, Jim Bob transitioned into new employment, working with his brother-in-law, K.L. Breeden, nephews Wynne and David, at Refrigerated

Transport. It was during this time that Jim Bob connected with, and married, the love of his life, Yvonne Hargrove, and gained two new children, Holly and Jason Hargrove, whom he deeply loved. Upon retirement, Jim Bob became more involved with his family's cattle operation, diligently caring for his livestock. He was not alone in this cattle endeavor; Yvonne worked the cows right alongside him. Jim Bob would often say that Yvonne was the best cowboy he ever had. One of his other favorite activities was antiquing with Yvonne. The two of them often visited First Monday Trade Days in Canton, and other antique hot spots, collecting many untold treasures over the years.

Many have shared that Jim Bob's greatest attributes were his joyful spirit, humorous nature, and razor-sharp wit, always having a spontaneous comeback ready at a moment's notice. He greatly enjoyed family gatherings where his playful nature shone the brightest. Jim Bob loved socializing and maintained close relationships until his death. Of all those he loved, the love he had for his granddaughters was truly the greatest.

Jim Bob is preceded in death by his loving parents; his beloved wife, Yvonne Wynne; his treasured son, James Robert Wynne; and, most recently, his cherished dog, Sassy. He is survived by his sister, Joanne Breeden; his children Holly and Dusty Tripp and Jason

Hargrove; his granddaughters, Danielle Wynne and her sister, Gillian Grace, and Sydney Tripp.

Jim Bob is also survived by sisters-in-law Nancy Clower and Betty Jo McMahan and many nieces, nephews, and additional family members.

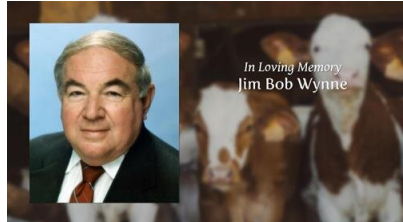
