James "Jim" Leo Kick, Jr of Forney, Texas, went to be with our Lord on October 22, 2025 at 76

years of age. Jim was born on March 26, 1949, in Monmouth, Illinois, to the parents of James Leo and Georgia Moore Kick. Jim is preceded in death by his parents and his sister, Peggy Ford.

Jim was raised in and around Pocahontas, Arkansas and graduated high school in 1967. Jim

was an avid hunter and fisherman. On April 23, 1968, Jim enlisted in the US Army where he served as a Quartermaster in Germany until his honorable discharge on April 1, 1974.
