



Jimmie Earl Brown Sr.

September 15, 1927 - August 14, 2023

Jimmie Earl Brown Sr. passed away peacefully with loved ones by his side on August 14, 2023. Jimmie was born on September 15, 1927 in Dallas, TX to Walter Brown and Susie Ella Stanley Horan. Both of his parents have preceded him in death along with his stepfather, Ben Horan; beloved wife, Bobby Jo Johnston Brown; daughter, Zelda Sue Brown Stewart; and great-grandson, Joey Villegan.

Jimmie bravely enlisted in the United States Navy and served his Country for 22 years. During that time, he met and fell in love with Bobby Jo Johnston Brown, who he married in March of 1950. He went on to become a Sheriff for the City of Dallas, TX and was also a member of The Masons for 72 years, and Shriner for 50 years and Scottish Rite for 51 years. After his retirements he moved to Able Springs, Texas where he and Bobby Joe raised cattle and Tennessee horses. He had additional time that he spent out doors as a scout assistant and loved to fish. He helped out in the Methodist Church as an usher, Sunday School Teacher and was president of the Methodist men.

Jimmie joined Kiwanis in Terrell two times and when he passed away he was the oldest member he was still active in Kiwanis until his passing.

He is survived by his sons, Ben C. Brown and wife Sherry and Jimmie E Brown Jr.; daughter, Yvonne Hoots-Brown, and husband David; grandsons, Cassidy Villegan, Benjamin Brown, and Bobby Stewart; granddaughters, Guenevere Villegan and Jessica Schmeltz, step grandchildren Robert Caughron and Jennifer Fojt; along with 11 great-grandchildren and two great-

great grandchildren plus numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and many friends. The grandchildren could not ask for a better Papa, he will be greatly missed.
