



John Riedel

July 30, 1981 - December 3, 2022

On Saturday, December 3, 2022, John Lawrence Riedel, beloved son and brother, died unexpectedly at his home in Terrell, TX. He was 41 years old. John was born on July 30, 1981, in Houston, TX to Linda and Larry Riedel. Three years later the family relocated to Schulenburg, TX where he developed a lifelong passion for wildlife and fishing. Moving to Sealy, TX five years later, John attended third to twelfth grade. After joining FFA during his sophomore year, he engaged in animal husbandry, raising bovines. Over the course of three years, John and his father, Larry, presented Limousin heifers at the Austin County Fair in Bellville, TX, and the Houston Livestock Show Rodeo. One of his finest accomplishments was competing in the calf scramble event at the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo. The calves ran at lighting speed, but John was faster. He wrangled a calf, winning the scramble. His sponsor was Dow Chemical Company. Shortly after graduating Sealy High School in 1999, he was employed with Steinhauser's, working on farms in the local area.

John is survived by his mother, Linda Riedel of Terrell, his father, Larry Riedel and wife Janice of Bakersfield, CA; sister, Jamie Riedel-Jetton and husband Jeff of Waco, TX; nieces: Meredith and Kate Jetton; aunt, Freida Baugh of Terrell, cousins, and friends. He is preceded in death by his grandparents: A.J. and Ruth Riedel, and James and Alta Baugh; aunt, Sally Riedel Liberty; uncle, Wes Baugh.
