John Daniel Rounsavall, of Wills Point, passed away peacefully on the evening of January 24, 2023 at his home with beloved family by his side. John grew up in Terrell and was a proud THS graduate of the class of 1977. John began a long and respected career with his hometown when he became a police officer with TPD. Under the guidance of Bobby Bishop, who was at the time the City Secretary for Terrell, John learned the ins and outs of municipal requirements of a growing community. The increasing expansion of Terrell allowed John to then become the City Finance Director, a position that was vital as he and other city officials navigated the new opportunities of Terrell while still keeping the history and small-town ambience that made it a great place to live and work. When he wasn’t working, John was a devoted husband and dad whose family was his number one priority. Always one to have a smile on his face, John’s smile become even bigger when he became a grandfather and, to him, there was nothing better than spending time with each grandkid. In 2015, he married Karen Parham, and they were blessed to have their families unite and support them in their lives. A man of integrity, honor and approachability, John will be always remembered for his loyalty and dedication to both his family and his community.
