Johnny Leon Clemons passed away Jan. 21, 2017 surrounded by his family. Johnny was born Jan. 29, 1939 in Kaufman County, Tx to Winford Claude and Alma Lee (Green) Clemons, both of whom preceded him in death. He proudly served his country in the US Army and was honorably discharged in 1961. Johnny worked for 27 years for Chevron as a truck driver and dispatcher where his work ethic and willingness to help people was well known. 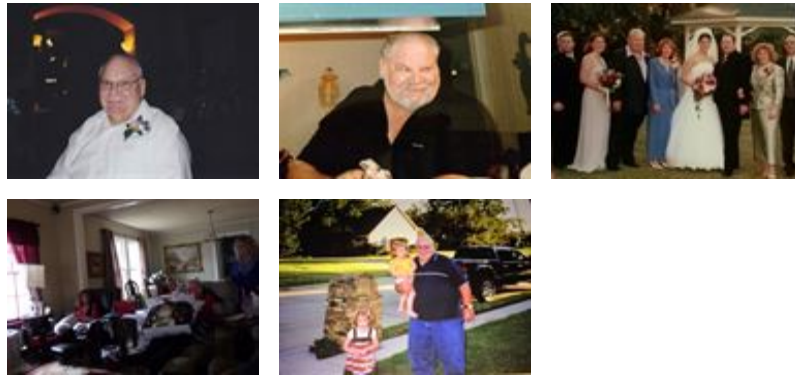
