Johnny Allen Vance, lifetime resident of Terrell, passed away peacefully at his home with family at his side on Aug. 28, 2025. Johnny was born on Jan. 7, 1950 at Colonial Hospital in Terrell to Johnny and Ruby Vance, both of whom preceded him in death along with his cousin, John Wayne Cody.

Johnny went to elementary school in Terrell and graduated Terrell High School in 1968. He then attended Henderson County Junior College where he met his soulmate, Sharon Cox.
