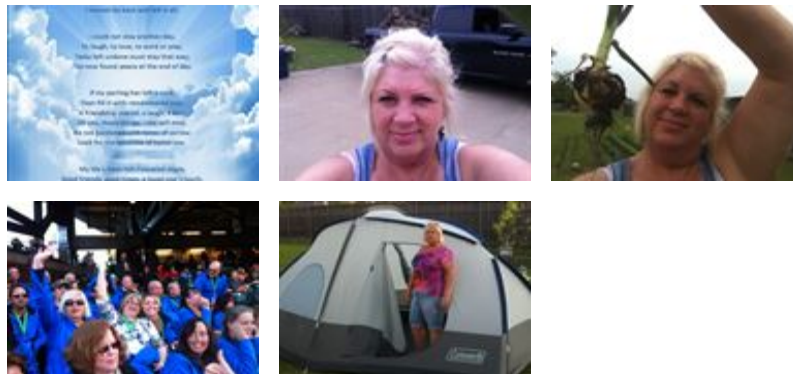
“ Momma Kim ,
