Lance Van Taylor, beloved husband, father, son, grandfather, and friend, passed away on May 26, 2023. Lance was born in Russellville, Arkansas on December 3, 1962 to Joe and JoAnn Taylor. Lance was welcomed into Heaven by his uncles, Charles Van Zandt and Charles Fowler, his grandparents: Jim and Ruth Van Zandt and JD and Ruby Taylor along with his mother-in-law, Nancy Martin.

Lance was a 1981 graduate of Sulphur Springs High School where he was a noted athlete. During his senior year, he set the record for average yards carried in varsity football and was voted MVP that year as well. He also loved hunting and racing motorcycles with his family and friends. “ I cry every time I think of Lance's death, so I won't leave condolences to all of you -- Joe, Jo Ann, Robin, Lane, Lakin, Brad, and all other family members.

Instead, I'll just share two of my fondest (and sometimes funniest) memories of Lance. The first is the 6-7-year old Lance who loved for his uncle to throw him and his brother and cousins pass after pass in the field across from Jim and Ruth's house. When a pass finally smashed his nose, he kept going -- every once in a while wiping the blood carefully on his shirt so that when he tucked in his shirt, it wasn't visible. I thought "what a tough little kid," but not tough enough to stand up and tell his mom he busted his nose and bloodied his shirt -- at least not this moment when there were still footballs to be caught.

The second was the last time I saw him, maybe a year ago. One weekend, Joe and Jo Ann had told Lance and Brad they could not stay with them - or maybe had to sleep on floors/couches - because Denise and I were staying at their house, so Lance and Brad had a brothers' weekend out and came by to visit Joe and Jo Ann and drop 100-200 jokes/barbed comments about getting no love or respect from their parents - or uncle. The Lance and Brad (or Brad and Lance, depending on who you asked) Show didn't stop there, but went on for another few hours of stand-up comedy. I have never seen Lance as animated and happy as on that day he and his brother conducted a "Roast" and comedy act. I saw the 6-year old boy.

I don't think the 60-year old man ever lost the 6-year old boy. And we are all sadder for not seeing either of them on earth again. But there will come a time, and I bet he will have a new show ready for us.
