August 29, 1942 - February 14, 2025

Larry John Carr (82) passed away February 14, 2025, at his home surrounded by family, after a lengthy battle with multi-myeloma cancer. Born August 29, 1942, to parents John and Jane Carr in Dallas, TX, but raised in Commerce TX by his grandparents, Bert and Lilly Jackson. Preceding him in death are his parents, grandparents, and half-sister Dorothy Jean Woodard.

thoughtful, and caring person. He was proud of his son Sean Carr a talented artist, hardworking, and responsible man. He was married to the love of his life and caregiver Jeanne Carr.

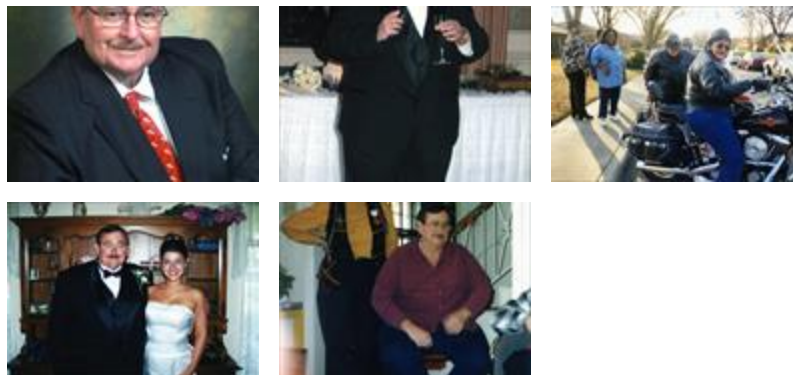
