



Lawrence "Bud" Galloway Riggs

June 19, 1930 - September 27, 2019

Lawrence Galloway "Bud" Riggs, 89, a life-time resident of Mesquite and Forney, Texas passed away at his home in Forney on Friday, September 27, 2019.

The family will receive visitors at First Baptist Church, Forney, Texas; 1003 College Avenue, Forney, Texas 75126 on Tuesday, October 1, 2019 from 5:00 to 7:00 pm.

Services will be held at First Baptist Church, Forney, Texas on Wednesday, October 2, 2019, at 1:00 pm. The Reverend Jerry Griffin will officiate.

Pallbearers will be Phillip Pyle, Michael Cates, Mark Poindexter, Larry Henard, David Baker and Bryan Beavers.

Burial will be at Mesquite Cemetery on Walker Street in Mesquite.

Bud was born on June 19, 1930, to Annie Galloway and Shelby Echol Riggs, his grandparents were Mittie Pearl Ballard and William Alfred Riggs, and Nannie Lawrence and Bedford Forest Galloway, all of Mesquite.

Bud began as a volunteer fireman while in high school then in 1958, the City of Mesquite went from volunteer to a paid fire department which Bud was the

first fireman to be hired. During his 25 years of service, Bud worked his way up through the ranks to retire in 1983 as Deputy Chief.

Bud worked with many smaller area Fire Department over the years, helping them find the right equipment for their community. By the early 1970's this had become a business which he operated until 2005.

Bud was also an instructor at Texas Fireman's Training School at Texas A & M University in College Station, Texas for 36 years.

He was predeceased by his eldest brother Shelby E. Riggs, Jr., and wife Mary Hill Riggs, and by his youngest brother Jarrell Edward "Jerry" Riggs.

He is survived by his wife of 67 years, Betty Ganze Riggs, their daughter Cheryl Riggs Ogden and husband Charles Anthony ("Tony") and son Brett of Maryland, as well as their son Paul D. Riggs, his wife Sharon Briscoe Riggs, and their daughters Kristi Edwards and husband Josh with two sons Blevin & Brinnon, and Kaci Myers and husband Cash with daughters Marli & Westi, sons Strait & Ketch.

Bud was the second of eight children, and is survived by Mary Ann Hearon and family of Arizona, Julia Riggs of Victoria, Texas, Carol Anderson and her husband Durward of Forney, Richard F. Riggs and his wife Juanita and family of Forney, Thomas B. Riggs and wife Barbara and family of Maryland.
