In Loving Memory of Liska McCasland

Liska La Tisha McCasland passed into the eternal care of Our Lord on September 17 following a long and courageous battle with illness.

Born on the Pueblo of Ohkay Owingeh (formerly San Juan Indian Reservation), she was a proud member of the Pueblo Nations in Northern New Mexico, near Santa Fe. In 1964, she was lovingly adopted by Jerry and Mamie McCasland and was raised in Richardson, Texas.

A graduate of J.J. Pearce High School, Liska excelled in the fine arts and shared her father's love of reading. A lifelong learner, she went on to earn her Bachelor of Arts degree from Texas Woman's University. Her Native American pottery earned an award from the State Fair of Texas.

Liska had a deep appreciation for music and was especially fond of classic rock, rap, and movie soundtracks. She was an avid fan of science fiction television and movies, and she had a special love for animals of all kinds.

For more than 30 years, Liska served with dedication as a records clerk in the Offices of the Dallas District Clerk and the Dallas County Clerk.

She will be remembered for her love, compassion, and thoughtful spirit. Liska is survived by her mother, three brothers, three nieces, a nephew, and her cat – all of whom will cherish her memory.

A service of remembrance will be at 3:00pm, Sunday, December 21, 2025 at the Columbarium of Oakland Memorial Park.
