Since Lydia had to raise her five children primarily by herself, she became quite self-sufficient. She had a wonderful sense of humor, a beautiful smile and was always in the middle of the

entertainment.

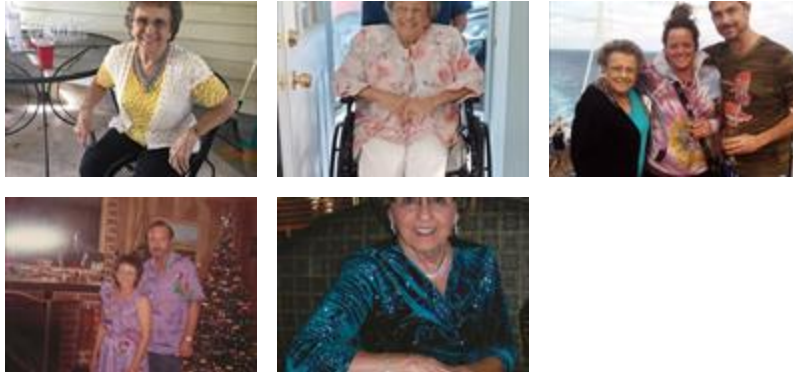
