Margie Enochs aka “Aunt Go”, a beloved wife, mother, granny, sister, aunt, friend, bible teacher, community organizer, seamstress, cake baker, wedding planner, hand & foot player, gardener, and so much more, passed away peacefully on Thursday, January 29, 2026.

She was preceded in death by her parents, a brother, a husband and a son. Her legacy is carried on by her daughter, 6 grandchildren, 5 great grandchildren, a surviving sibling, and extended family including 2 bonus daughters and their children and grandchildren.

Margie was born at home in Kaufman County, Texas in June of 1942. She met and married her high school sweetheart in Terrell. Over the years, she remained closely connected with her high school friends, gathering regularly until her passing, a testament to her loyalty and love for others.

She cherished a wide and loving community of friends who brought her great joy. Many of these friendships grew through her church family and the clubs and sororities in which she was actively involved.

A natural organizer and creative spirit, one way Margie expressed her talents was through her business, Creations by ME. For 4 decades, she planned and coordinated events and weddings including baking and decorating

extravagant, delicious wedding cakes (in some families she made the wedding cake for multiple generations of brides). A frequent traveler, she saw the nation and the world with family and friends. In each USA state visited, Margie purchased a ring from a local pawn shop.

In many ways, Margie was a multiplier. By sharing her faith openly with family, friends, and neighbors, she witnessed the fruit of her labor as that generation of new believers shared their faith with the next generation and so on. Still multiplying into her late 70's and early 80's she was a leader in an after-school experience oriented around the Bible, called KiDs Beach Club.

In the last 5 months, while living at an assisted living center, Margie made more friends, organized a twice weekly game of hand & foot, and had a huge impact for good on her caregivers. A huge thank you to all who helped Margie with her transition to assisted living and to all who visited/cared for Margie over the last few months. She will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved her.
