Mark Stephen Calverley, of Terrell, passed away on October 22, 2022. He was born September 27, 1959 to Leonard & Mary Calverley. Mark is preceded in death by his mother, Mary, his brother Bobby Glenn Calverley and his grandson, Brenton Lane Huffines.

Mark graduated from Skyline High School in Dallas in 1977. Mark began working at an early age and had a very strong work ethic which carried him through many careers, the last of which was a nursing home Maintenance Director. 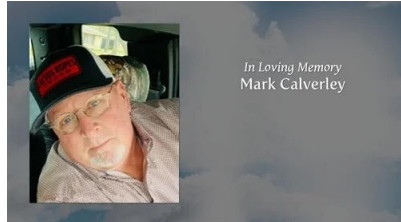
