Marlene Elmore Arnold passed away peacefully in Rockwall, TX on May 27, 2025, surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Cullman, AL on July 23, 1935, to Horace Dewey Elmore and Ora Elizabeth Boyd Elmore. Marlene was welcomed into Heaven by her parents, her husband, Ray Arnold, son James Marlin Arnold and his wife, Carol, sister Peggy Kline and her husband, Dick, as well as her grandson, David Bradley Arnold.

She married Alvin “Ray” Arnold on February 4, 1953, in Madera, CA where they both grew up together. While in California they lived in several different cities but ultimately moved to Texas in 1963. They settled in Forney, TX in January 1964 where they raised their three sons.

Marlene was an active member of Chisholm Baptist Church and most recently First Baptist Church of Terrell. When she could no longer drive, she faithfully watched both First Baptist Church Terrell and Lakepointe Church Rockwall’s online services. Marlene was a powerful prayer warrior during these services and her comments on the livestreams were filled with encouraging words for other viewers and pastoral staff! She treasured the members of her Sunday School Class and her friendship with each class member filled Marlene’s heart with joy.

Marlene retired from Marsh & McLennan after 20+ years of service. Once

retired, she decided she did not like being idle, so she returned to Marsh on a contract basis for several years. She “tested” retirement again, but alas she went to work at Talty Water Supply for another 10 years and finally called it quits at age 80.

Ray’s passing in 2006 left a big void in her heart. They were married just shy of 53 years and she missed him every day. However, she filled her life with family and friends – to whom she was faithfully devoted. Her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren were always at the forefront of her thoughts and prayers. She enjoyed travelling, making several trips with her sons and especially the trips to Lake Havasu, AZ to visit her brother and sister-in-law. Her trusted companion in her final days was her Boston Terrier, Tippy.
