



## Maye Taffer

July 6, 1939 - November 6, 2022

Maye Taffer, longtime Terrell resident, passed away November 6, 2022 at her residence. She was born in Terrell to the late James Madison and Annie Frances Darst Taffer. Maye graduated from Terrell High School in 1957 and soon after joined the U.S. Army where she served with honor for 3 years. She worked at Baylor Scott and White in Dallas and retired after 43 years of dedicated service. Maye was an active and devoted member of Rockwall and Brin Church of Christ where she taught Sunday School in the children's department for 32 years. She had a servant's heart and could often be found seeing how she could help others. Maye was also a lifelong Terrell Tiger Football fan and was a frequent attendee in the bleachers when she was able to go. 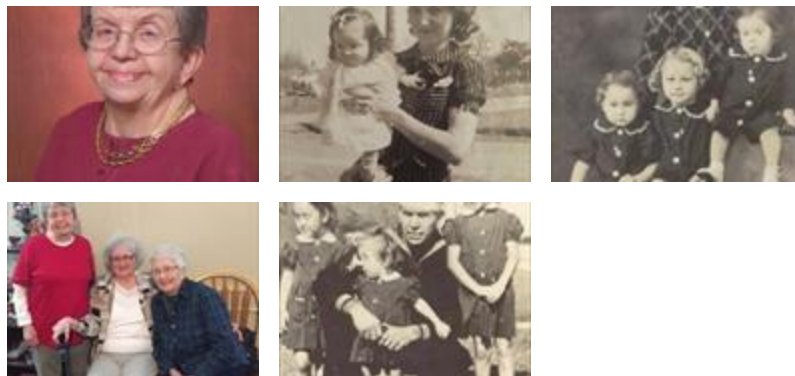
