October 20, 1941 - January 7, 2020

Ned Davis Bryant, long time resident of Forney, passed away January 7, 2020 in Dallas, Texas. Ned was born October 20, 1941 in Dallas to David Culberson and Willie Mae (Davis) Bryant. Ned faithfully and proudly served his country in the U.S. Army during Vietnam until his honorable discharge, after which he returned to home, moving to Forney in 1972. He worked for, and retired from, Hunt Oil Company with 41 years of dedicated and loyal service. Ned was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Forney as well as the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 137.

Ned was preceded in death by his parents, and the love of his life and wife of over 47 years Linda Roland Bryant, who recently passed away on August 9, 2019 as well as his sister, Juanita Pearl Bryant.

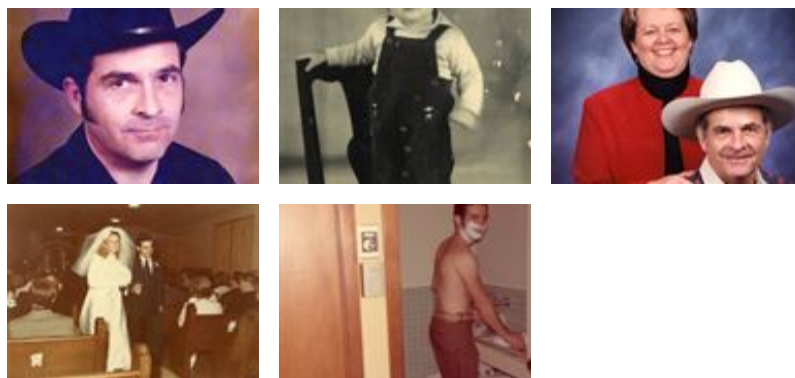
