



Nicole Jarke

September 9, 1979 - March 28, 2024

We are heartbroken to announce the passing of Nicole Jarke, age 44, of Dallas. She passed away in the early hours on Thursday, March 28, 2024, after a courageous battle with cancer.

Nicole was born in Tulsa, OK on September 9, 1979. She had five beloved brothers and, as the only girl, she grew up to be fiercely independent with a strong belief in what was right and wrong. She excelled in school, spending a semester in Redding, England and Oxford and graduated from Randolph Macon College for Women. Nicole taught college for a year in Prague. She developed a lifelong love of literature and was an avid reader. She loved the arts and was a talented musician playing the cello piano, guitar and harp. She was a passionate mom to her two Golden Retrievers, who are also grieving her passing.

Nicole spoke multiple languages including Arabic. She proudly served in the US Army as an E-5 Sgt and was a trained interpreter and interrogator. She was stationed in Iraq and was awarded the Bronze Star. Upon leaving the service, Nicole served at the National Fusion Center and the National Counterterrorism Center before moving to Homeland Security Investigations and SAC Intelligence where she worked as a criminal analyst.

Nicole is survived by her husband, Todd Burnes; stepchildren, Colton and Haven Burnes; mother, Susan (Patrick) Brezina; father, Richard (Phyllis) Jarke; brothers: Brian (Holly) Jarke, Richard N. Jarke, Michael (Kara) Jarke, Brandon (Danielle) Jarke, and Matthew (Shae) Jarke. Nicole was the beloved

“Auntie Blondie” to her treasured nieces and nephew: Eva, Piper, Reagan
, Logan and Kabel.

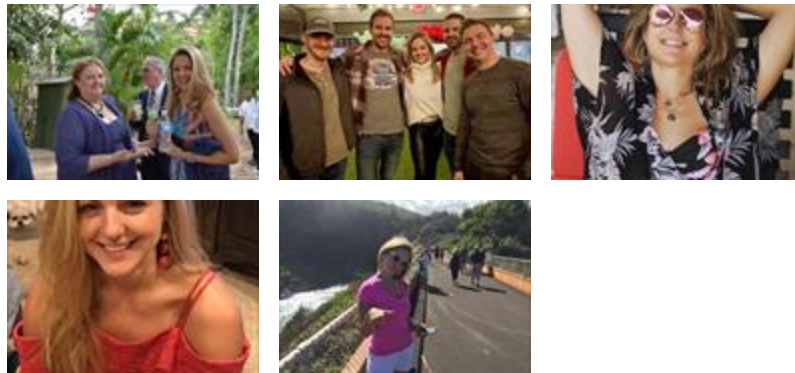

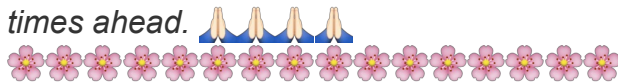
