Norma Helm Jandrew, of Terrell, passed away peacefully surrounded by family on April 9, 2017. 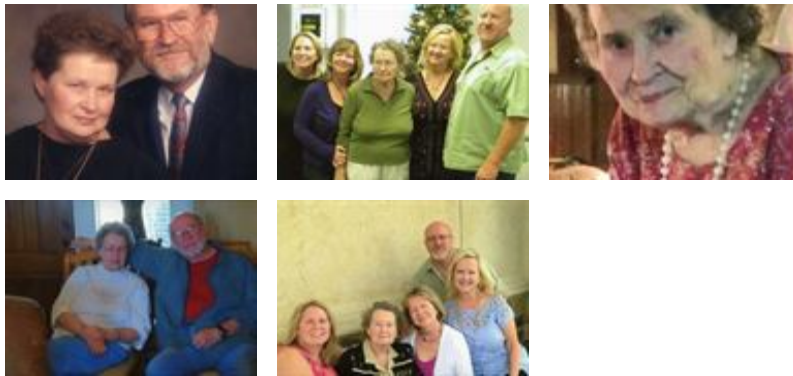

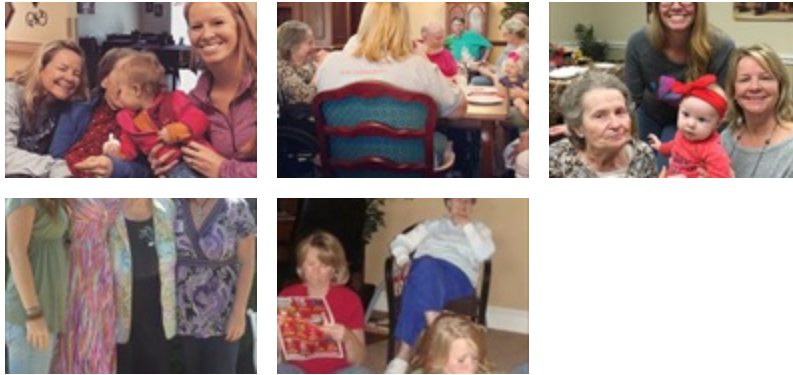

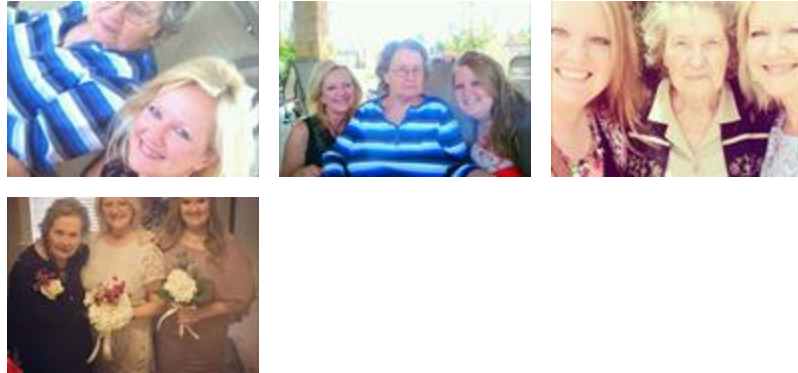
