Oneta Ritchie Ott, passed away March 29, 2017 in Terrell surrounded by her loving family. She was born March 19, 1921 in Kaufman County, Tx to Neb and Maudie Jay (Baxter) Hargrove. She was met in Heaven by her Savior, her parents, her husbands, Wayne Ritchie, who passed in 1980, and Wilbert Ott, who passed in 1996 and eight brothers and sisters.

Being born in the era of the Great Depression, Oneta learned early in life that a good work ethic was just as important as a loving family during good and challenging times. She first saw the love of her life, Wayne Ritchie, when she was 13 years old when he came to visit with her father. He immediately asked Neb permission to take her on a date after which they dated for 6 years until marrying on Jan. 11, 1940. During that 6 years, Wayne would work hard to grow many business opportunities that both he and Oneta worked side by side to develop. Never one to sit idle, she and her husband, Wayne Ritchie, could be found together at the many commercial ventures they established together from gas stations to a laundromat to rental properties. After Wayne's death, her complete trust in the Lord helped her concentrate on continuing to work as well as staying involved with their children.

She later married Wilbert (Bill) Ott in 1983 and they shared 13 wonderful years until his passing in 1996. Oneta had been a faithful member of both First United Methodist Church where she taught Sunday School for over 30

years. She was also a devoted member of College Mound United Methodist church where she was active in the United Methodist Womens Ministry as well as other ministries that highlighted her personality of service above self. Never being one to slow down, Oneta loved walking, was a fabulous dancer, and she was known for being an enthusiastic Dallas Cowboys fan during all their seasons. A vibrant personality with the warmest and most genuine smile, Oneta will be missed by all whose lives she touched.
