Patricia Ann LaRoe, 93 a longtime resident of Terrell passed away peacefully on April 23, 2025.

She also enjoyed going dancing, dining out and cooking, where she knew her way around the kitchen. 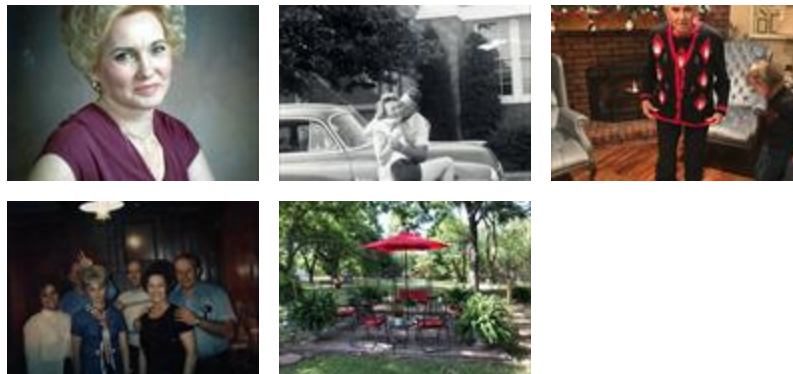
