Phyllis consistently took charge as “show mom” and “team mom”, extending her love to all others involved. She was a strong, fierce and independent woman who never expected others to do what she wasn't willing to do herself. Her beautiful spirit and generous heart will be missed by all who knew her.

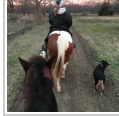
