Ray Appleton, formerly of Terrell, passed away peacefully on June 20, 2021. Ray's smile and willingness to help became a welcome sight to fellow employees and customers at the store where he was known as "Mr. Encyclopedia" because of his vast knowledge. Ray's commitment to work was second only to his commitment to his family. He was a devoted husband to his wife, Jill, until her passing in 1998. He found love again with Audrey, and they were married

on Sept. 3, 1999, in Las Vegas. They were wonderful parents and grandparents to their new blended family, all of whom they loved like each was their own. He spent a lifetime enjoying the outdoors, especially fishing with his family, and was known among many for his "Appleton Fish Fry" events. He was also a member of the Tyler Lodge No. 1233 in Tyler. A wonderful man who never met a stranger and made everyone feel like family, Ray will be missed by all who knew him.
