Elmer Loyd “Ray” Brown, Jr., of Terrell, passed away January 1, 2016. Ray was born Jan. 11, 1934 in Greenville, Texas to Elmer Loyd, Sr. and Mable (Mitchell) Brown, both of whom preceded him in death. Ray was raised in the Church of Christ and was a true servant of the Lord. He was dedicated to serving others and he enlisted in the US Army and then National Guard where he served honorably for 22 years until retiring.
