Jimmy Rebecca Moss, beloved wife, mother and friend, passed away peacefully on July 19, 2024. Rebecca was born in Wills Point, Texas on October 1, 1946, to Robert Leland and Anne Catherine Slayton, both of whom preceded her in death along with brother Jerry Bob Slayton.

Rebecca graduated from Terrell High School as the last graduating class of that historic campus located at the corner of College St. and N. 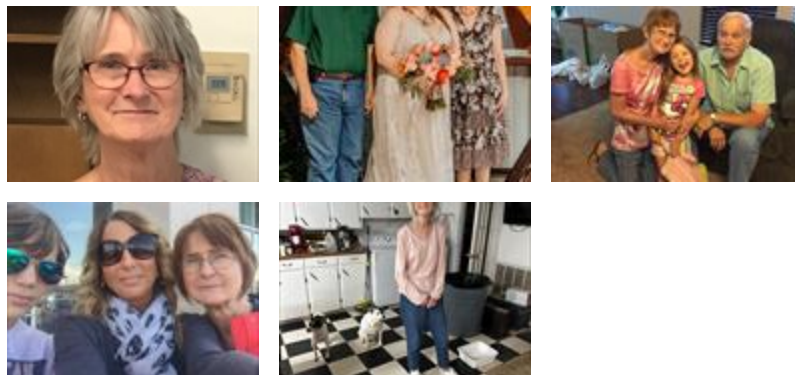
