David Richard Barrow, of Terrell, passed away peacefully on February 9, 2022. He was born in Greenville, Texas, to James William and Frances Lorita Barrow, both of whom met him in Heaven along with his first wife Kay, who passed in 2009, and his second wife Belinda, who passed in 2018.

Richard grew up in, and was a longtime member of, the First Christian Church of Terrell and later in life was a faithful member of the First Baptist Church of Terrell. Richard married the love of his life, Kay, on July 1, 1972, and together they made their home in Terrell where they raised their two sons. He was a fixture at any event they participated in and was active in the community, including serving on the Terrell ISD School Board for 10 years.
